*****Turn in times:Chicken-Noon Ribs-12:30 Pork-1pm Brisket-1:30*****

1. All contestants are responsible for reading and following the KCBS rules and regulations.
2. All contestants must adhere to all electrical, fire and other codes (city, county, state, or federal codes).
3. Each team should have a fire extinguisher in good working.
4. Alcoholic beverages are not to be distributed (given away or sold) to the general public by contestants.
5. Food or any other items are not to be sold to the general public by contestants.
6. All teams are requested to respect the rights of other teams with special emphasis on loud music, language or infringement of adjoining site with equipment, etc. The Chief cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guests.
7. If a Chief Cook decides to withdraw, he/she must notify a contest rep immediately.
8. The Kennett Jaycees BBQ Committee reserves the right to make additional rules and regulations as the situation warrants. Decisions of the committee are final.
9. Each competing team will receive 5 entry tickets for the weekend all other guests will be charged admission.
